

Alice M. Krall Gullickson

June 3, 1932 – July 9, 1998



Alice M. Gullickson, 87, of Sioux Falls, SD, passed away on Sunday, December 5, 2004, at Avera McKennan Hospital. A devoted mother, community member, and longtime houseparent at the South Dakota School for the Deaf (SDSD), Alice is fondly remembered by many former dormitory students for her kind presence and steady guidance during their school years.

Born in Elkton, South Dakota, on August 9, 1917, to James and Helen

Zarecky) Krall, Alice spent her early years in Flandreau and graduated from Flandreau High School in 1936. She married Kenneth I. Gullickson in 1937, and the couple moved to Sioux Falls in 1952. Kenneth passed away in 1960.

Alice began working at SDSD in the early 1960s and retired in 1984. Adding to her connection with the Deaf community, her sister Margaret Krall was a proud alumna of SDSD, graduating with the Class of 1948. She
