

Robert J. Kelley

June 5, 1950 – February 25, 2001

Robert J. Kelley, 50, Fort Collins, Colorado, died Sunday, February 25, 2001, in Fort Collins, Colorado.

He was born in Rapid City, South Dakota and, at the age of 6, he entered South Dakota School for the Deaf. He graduated in 1968 and attended the Charles City Linotype School in Iowa, then worked as a printer in Mitchell, South Dakota. Later on, he attended the Technical Vocational Institute in St. Paul, Minnesota. He moved to Fort Collins, Colorado in 1971 and worked as a printer there for Forney Industries. He resided in Fort Collins, Colorado for 30 years.

Survivors include his father and stepmother, Phillip Kelley and Mary Davies, Rapid City, SD; and one brother, David Kelley, Portland, Oregon.

His remains were cremated and a memorial services was held for him on March 3, 2001 at Fort Collins, Colorado and July 8, 2001 at the Osheim-Catron Funeral Home in Rapid City, South Dakota. His ashes were interred at the Mount Calvary Cemetery in Rapid City, South Dakota.
