October 22, 1926 – January 30, 1991

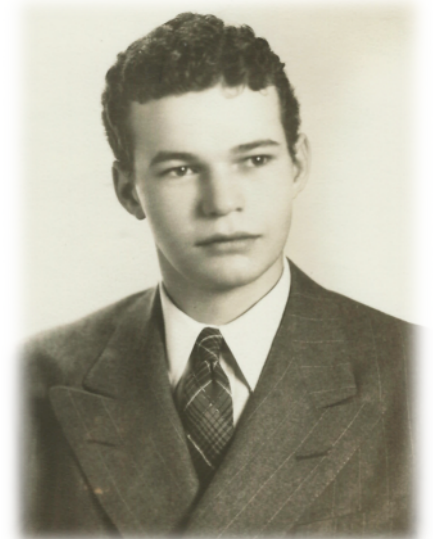


Blaine Solvey, 64, of Anaheim, a printer for the Long Beach Press Telegram died Wednesday, January 30, 1991 at Orange, California.
