

E. G. Wright (fl. 1880s) was a resident of Sioux Falls in the early 1880s who is noted in local records associated with the early days of the Dakota Territorial School for the Deaf. He is historically connected through his sister Jennie Wright, the first teacher at the SDSD, and appears in civic directories from that era. Detailed biographical records about his life and career have not yet been fully researched.
