

Alma Christina Anderson Saba

December 6, 1908 – July 21, 1990



Alma Christina Anderson was born in December 6, 1908 in Rutland, South Dakota, and enrolled at the South Dakota School for the Deaf in 1914. While it is not certain how many years she remained at SDSD, a group photo suggests she was still attending into the mid-1920s.

She later moved to Minnesota and married Donald Saba on July 30, 1943, in Minneapolis. The couple resided in the Twin Cities area until Donald's passing in 1966. Alma passed away in July 21, 1990 in Ramsey County, likely in St. Paul, Minnesota, at the age of 82.

She was laid to rest at St. Anthony Cemetery in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Although little is known about her involvement in the Deaf community after SDSD, Alma is fondly remembered by those who have preserved her memory through photographs and archival efforts.
