Margaret Delvaux was born on November 7, 1899, in Cavour. She attended the South Dakota School for the Deaf in Sioux Falls, SD. She graduated in 1919.

On January 10, 1923, she married Oscar C. Skorheim. They lived in Huron, SD. Mr. Skorheim died November 22, 1977.

Survivors included two sons: Harold, Huron; and Norman, Whittier, CA; seven grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; and two brothers.
